The California Association of Health Underwriters (CAHU) regrets we must OPPOSE your AB 2436, as amended April 6, 2016, as it seeks to add new, unnecessary paperwork mandates to prescription process.

While CAHU supports the author's efforts to bring additional transparency in medical costs, including prescription drugs, AB 2436 does not help in that regard. AB 2436 adds new paperwork mandates by requiring the disclosure to a consumer by a health plan the prescription drug's cost in Germany, Mexico and Canada, among other provisions. CAHU does not believe that health plans have or control this information. It more appropriately should be asked of the drug manufacturer.
