Parametrix moving to Puyallup

Parametrix is moving from its offices in Sumner to the South Hill Business and Technology Center in Puyallup. This is the former Fairchild Semiconductor campus now being developed by Benaroya Company for office tenants.

The engineering and planning firm, Parametrix, will occupy 37,000 square feet in the West building beginning in December. More than 110 employees will be moving from two separate buildings in downtown Sumner.

"Our Sumner offices have almost doubled over the past decade, and we are eager to bring our team back together in one building and have space for growth," said office principal Dan McReynolds. "The new space provides a large, flexible floor plan that fits our collaborative work style, allows for growth, and minimizes commutes, while keeping our office close to long-term clients."

The company, which was founded in Sumner during 1969, has offices across the western United States and more than 500 employees who provide multi-disciplinary services in transportation, natural resources, community building, water solutions, and environmental engineering and science.
