**PURPOSE:**

From time to time, disputes between chapters may occur. This policy outlines procedures for resolution of these disputes.

**PROCEDURE(S):**

- A. Chapters may request assistance from CAHIP. Chapters must request such assistance in writing either from the Chapter President or the majority of the Chapter Board.
- B. The CAHIP President shall initiate an AD HOC Committee specifically to address each dispute, depending upon the nature of the cause. The Ad Hoc Committee shall include CAHIP President, Immediate Past President, President Elect and the CAHIP Board of Directors Vice President responsible for the area of conflict. For example, if there is a dispute regarding Legislative advocacy territories, the Vice President of Legislation shall be included.
- C. The Ad Hoc Committee is encouraged to complete their review and recommendation as expeditiously as possible. The Committee is also encouraged to seek expert advice from outside the Association to help in a speedy resolution.
- D. No Committee recommendation shall abrogate any Chapter rights conferred upon it by NABIP, CAHIP or their Chapter Bylaws, and/or the California Corporations Code.

Example: This includes, but is not limited to, disputes about legislative territory responsibility, geographical boundaries, event scheduling conflicts.
