Dear Governor Brown:

The California Association of Health Underwriters (CAHU) respectfully requests a **SIGNATURE** upon **SB 126** (**Steinberg**), which is currently on your desk awaiting action. **SB 126** ensures continued coverage for those with autism or developmental disorders by providing a five-year extension to the existing program.

SB 126 extends, until July 1, 2019, the sunset date of an existing state health benefit mandate that requires health plans and health insurance policies to cover behavioral health therapy for pervasive developmental disorder or autism.

Health plans and health insurers are already required to provide coverage for these conditions provided it is medically necessary under both state and federal health parity laws. CAHU believes that **SB 126** will keep an important door open for five more years to ensure those diagnosed with pervasive developmental or autism receive medically necessary treatment from qualified autism services providers.

CAHU is the state's largest association of health insurance agents, brokers and other health insurance industry professionals. Our members help millions of individual Californians and businesses evaluate, select, purchase and use their health care coverage plans, resulting in greater health and financial security.
