Dear Senator DeSaulnier:

The California Association of Health Underwriters (CAHU) **SUPPORTS** your **SB 1446**, as amended April 28, 2014, to provide small employers with non-grandfathered health insurance plans purchased by October 1, 2013 (including those policies renewed by December 31, 2013) the option to renew their existing coverage for one year.

As amended, SB 1446 provides a short, one-year window where employers with 50 or fewer employees will be able to renew their "grandfathered" health insurance group plan rather than be mandated to move to federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA) compliant coverage by the end 2014. SB 1446 moves state requirements closer to recent federal policy changes that allow for a longer transition period to ACA compliant group policies

Small employers with 50 or less employees who renew their existing coverage under the proposed transition policy in **SB 1446** will have an extra year to convert to new coverage (December 31, 2015), if the small business had not already purchased an ACA-compliant policy. CAHU believes **SB 1446** will provide some small employers additional flexibility by providing the additional year to transition to new policies.
