SUBJECT: AB 1309 (Bauer-Kahan) Health Care Coverage: Enrollment Periods

Dear Assemblymember Bauer-Kahan:

The California Association of Health Underwriters (CAHU) is pleased to **SUPPORT** your measure **AB 1309**, as proposed to be amended coming off of the Assembly Appropriations Committee's Suspense File, which would extend the enrollment periods for individuals both on and off of the California Health Benefits Exchange (Covered California) in 2020 from November 1, 2019 through January 31, 2020.

Extending special enrollment into January allows agents to reach more consumers and get them enrolled during a very busy time of year – the Holiday season. Further, **AB 1309** gives agents and brokers the opportunity to adequately help mitigate the harmful impacts on consumers from ongoing rate increases, and uncertainty due to constant changes at the federal level.

CAHU has been an active stakeholder, supporter and participant with Covered California and as a result, the percentages of those who are uninsured are at record lows.
